Quick Installation

Always double check the contents of the package to see if anything is missing or damaged.

- 1. Un-package both the TAG-400 and the Thermal Printer and set them both on a flat open area.
- 2. Connect the Thermal Printer to the console port on the TAG-400 with the provided RS-232 serial cable.
- 3. Connect the power plug to both units.
- 4. Switch on the printer.
- 5. Connect the LAN1 port directly to a internet connection to provide the internet service.
- Connect the LAN2 LAN4 ports to the client side. Computers, hubs/switches or APs.
 a. Please use cross-over cable anytime when connecting a computer directly to LAN2-LAN4 ports.
- 7. Set your computer to obtain an IP address automatically.
